About the report

Scores on the GRIMS range from one to nine, with a score of one representing an excellent relationship and a score of nine representing one that is in very severe difficulties. A score of five is average. The scoring process was derived from a broad spectrum of comparison groups, ranging from attendees at relationship counselling clinics, through participants in large scale surveys such as the Millennium Cohort Study, to those about to consolidate their relationship through marriage vows or another ceremony.
